Ray Feeser let all know of his interest in serving on the Board of Directors. President, John Delehant responded by thanking him for his interest and let him know we would add him to the ballot. Heather Nelson asked about our water supply and Ann Feeser asked about our service area. General Manager, Rick Koon responded by letting them know we would address both questions in the General Manager's Report portion of the meeting.

- V. REVIEW and APPROVAL OF MINUTES

## VII. NEW BUSINESS -

- a. Stage II Water Conservation is working well, with an overall reduction in water use of 30%. It is the staff's recommendation that we stay in Stage II Conservation. With Financial Officer, Tom Athey's recommendation to re-look at it in July, a motion was made to continue with Stage II Water Conservation by John Delehant, seconded by Tom Athey. Motion passed 5 0 (Vic Montgomery not available for vote)
- b. Annual meeting May 20<sup>th</sup> 2:00pm. BOD would like ballots to be mailed out by May 5<sup>th</sup> 2015. All shareholders must have account current to vote their share and absentee ballots must be received by close of business day on May 15<sup>th</sup> 2015 4:30pm. Motion made by Ben Banks, seconded by John Delehant. Motion passed 5-0
- c. Draft 2014 Financial Review General Manager Koon reviewed the summary financials with the BOD.

#### VIII. GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

- Administration
  - In response to Mrs. Nelson question about our water supply, General Manager Koon reviewed the DWR projected state water deliveries. At this time state water is 20% which amounts to only using 20 acft of our carryover water in 2015.

- -General Manger Koon presented and reviewed the photograph / drawing of our service area boundaries in response to Ann Feesers question.
- Santa Clara Valley Water Authority has asked SLO County if there was any interest from any State Water Subcontractors with carry over water, to sell them carry over water. SMMWC responded that we were not interested at this time.
- We have had a higher than normal number of customers using online bill pay with late charges. We're letting customers know they should be allowing at least 10 days for processing and mail time.
- We have received a medical exemption request from our Conservation Usage. Upon review, the request was granted.

## - Operations

- -Water
- Heron Crest Booster Station Updating to the VFD's and control equipment have been completed.
- Kingfisher Booster Station New VFD's have been installed and the final booster pump was installed.
- Staff is looking into installing a solar powered chlorinator at tank 400 similar to the one installed at 100 & 200.
- -Wastewater
- The WWTP continues to operate efficiently.
- All lift stations are functioning normally.
- The Hydrodyne is scheduled for its 5year service in April.
- Capital Projects
- Lift Station #3, pump #2 removal and rebuilding has begun and the pump was removed. The impeller is being re-chromed where needed.
