



## Election of SMMWC Board of Directors

In 2023 the Board of Directors has a total of Three (3) positions available, for a four-year term. Each Shareholder will have 3 votes per share since there are 3 positions in total available. The three (3) candidates with the highest number vote will be elected to the Board of Directors.

You can cast your ballot in one of 3 manners.

- 1) Cast your vote by using the mail in ballot that you will receive in the Annual Meeting Notice. Mail in ballots must be received by May 18, 2023, at 4:30pm.
- 2) Cast your vote in our office on May 19, 2023, before 2:00pm using a meeting ballot.
- 3) Proxy your vote using the mail in ballot you receive in the Annual Meeting Notice.

**All votes will be kept confidential and will be counted under the supervision of an Election Inspectors from the League of Women Voters, with oversight by Julie Rodewald, a former SLO County Clerk. Ballots and proxies must be received by SMMWC by 4:30 pm on May 19, 2023, or you may cast your vote in person at the annual meeting prior to 2:00pm.
